Tip

Cut after Cut for Vibrant Color

- **Timing is crucial:** cut your flowers in the morning or evening. This way, they avoid the midday heat and will stay fresh much longer.
- **Cutting the stems:** use a sharp knife or garden shears and always cut at an angle to help the stems absorb water more effectively.
- **Pro Tip:** place your flowers in clean, lukewarm water immediately after cutting.
- **Playing with shapes:** combine flowers with both small and large buds to create a harmonious arrangement.
- **Upcycling:** transform old glass jars into beautiful vases. With the right blooms, simple bottles become charming table decorations.

 - A burst of freshness: **bury a porous clay pot filled with water near your seedlings**; this allows the roots to stay hydrated deep underground.
 - **The ultimate water source:** install a rainwater harvesting **tank** so you always have a **sustainable supply of water** ready for your garden.
 - **Work smarter:** use a rainwater pump to water your garden and lawn, saving you the effort of carrying heavy watering cans across the yard.

The nasturtium is a flower with brightly colored petals and a spicy flavor. Our neighbor Emilia, who is passionate about gardening, shows us how to grow it indoors:

01 Fill a **pot** to the brim with soil and press down firmly to compact it.



02 Space the nasturtium **seeds** about **5 cm apart across the surface**. Push them deep into the soil and cover the holes.

03 Gently water the soil, cover the pot with **cling film** and place it in a **bright spot**.

Gather your supplies: get hold of a sturdy pallet, **wood stain**, a **paintbrush**, **sandpaper**, **screws**, and an **angle grinder with suitable accessories**.

02

Prepare the wood: clean the pallet thoroughly, **smooth the rough edges**, and remove the inner planks. This will create plenty of room for your plants.

03

Protect the surface: treat the pallet with **wood stain** or colored paint, making it weatherproof and **ready for the outdoors**.

04

Mounting: place or attach the pallet to a wall. Regardless of the wall material, screw the pallet in securely with a battery-operated screwdriver.

05

The finishing touch: something's still missing! **Plant your favorites on the pallet** using small pots, planters, or cloth pockets for the intermediate spaces.



Revive the Past with Nature: Ideas for Your Herb Garden

It just takes a little imagination to transform everyday objects into unique pots for your plants. **Glass jars** are perfect for herbs and flowers, while **old jam jars, Tetra Pak containers, or even grandma's vintage dishes** offer endless creative possibilities.

This is how sustainable, one-of-a-kind pieces are born—bringing a truly personal style to your balconies, terraces, and gardens.

Lea's Upcycling Tips

You can get a unique and original style by using a range of different jars. To achieve a real “wow effect” hang the jars with ribbons on a beam or railing.





Green Oasis: How to Grow Lush Vegetables

Keep things cool: raised beds dry out quickly in summer. **Mulching protects soil from water evaporation** and keeps roots fresh.

Protect from heat: protect plants that like to stay in the sun such as **tomatoes and peppers** with **linen sheets** or with taller plants such as sunflowers.

Watering: water in the **morning**, to allow the plants to absorb water more effectively and keep the leaves dry.

Seasonal harvests: pick courgettes, cucumbers and tomatoes **regularly** to promote regrowth.

The secret is to mix: plant **tomatoes and basil close together**. This saves space and they will protect each other from pests.

A power boost: after the first harvest spread **organic fertilizer** or **compost** for an extra power boost.

- 01 Separate the mango pulp from the core. Place the mango pulp, the juice of two **limes**, **sugar**, **mineral water** and fresh mint **leaves** in a **tall container**.
- 02 Using a **hand blender**, blend everything until smooth, then taste. Depending on the degree of ripeness of the mango adjust by adding more lime juice (for a more bitter flavor) or more sugar (for a sweeter flavor)
- 03 Transfer the mango mixture to the **granita machine** e **turn it on** until the mixture reaches the typical consistency of granita. Pour into glasses and decorate with fresh mint and slices of lime.

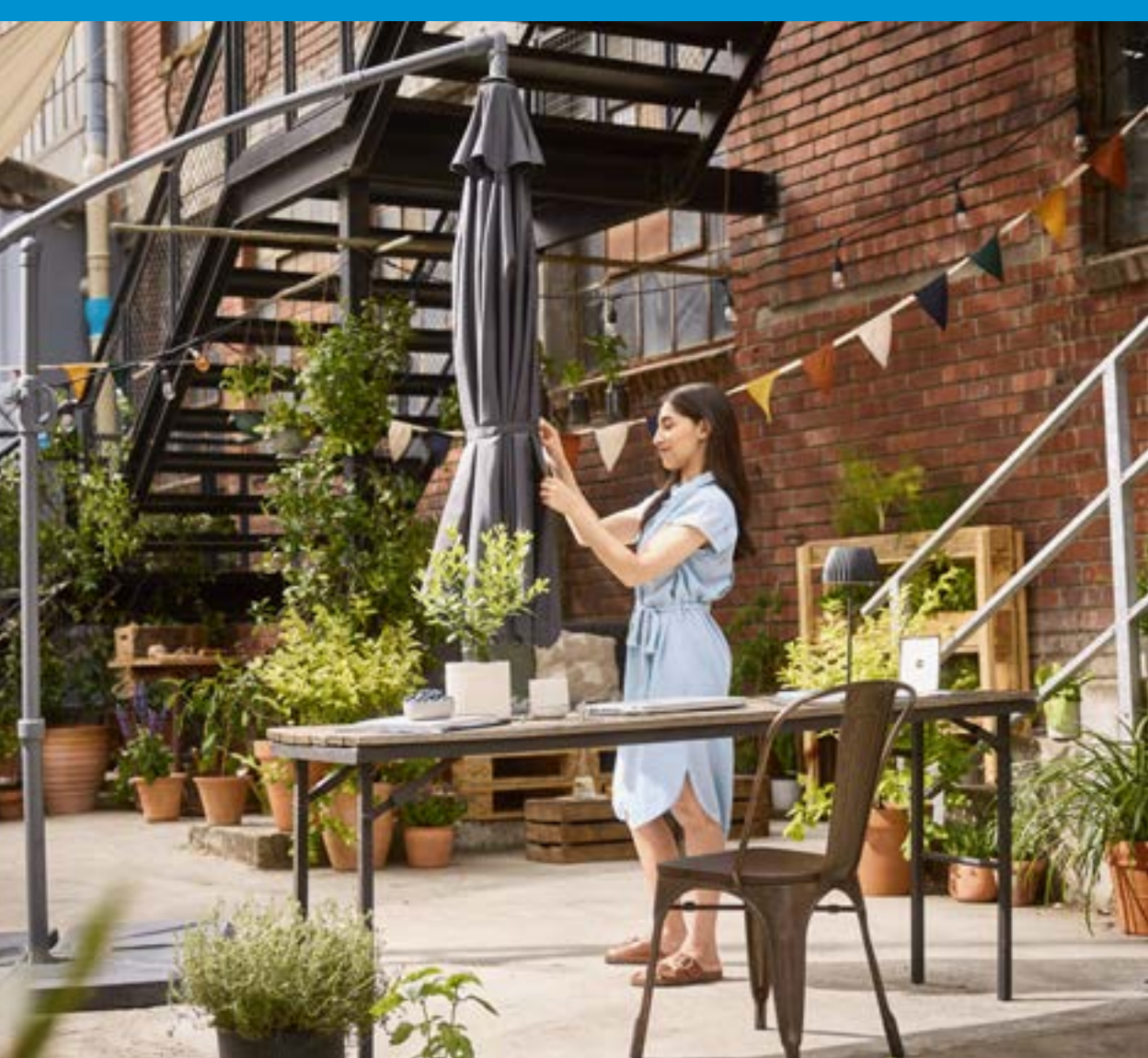

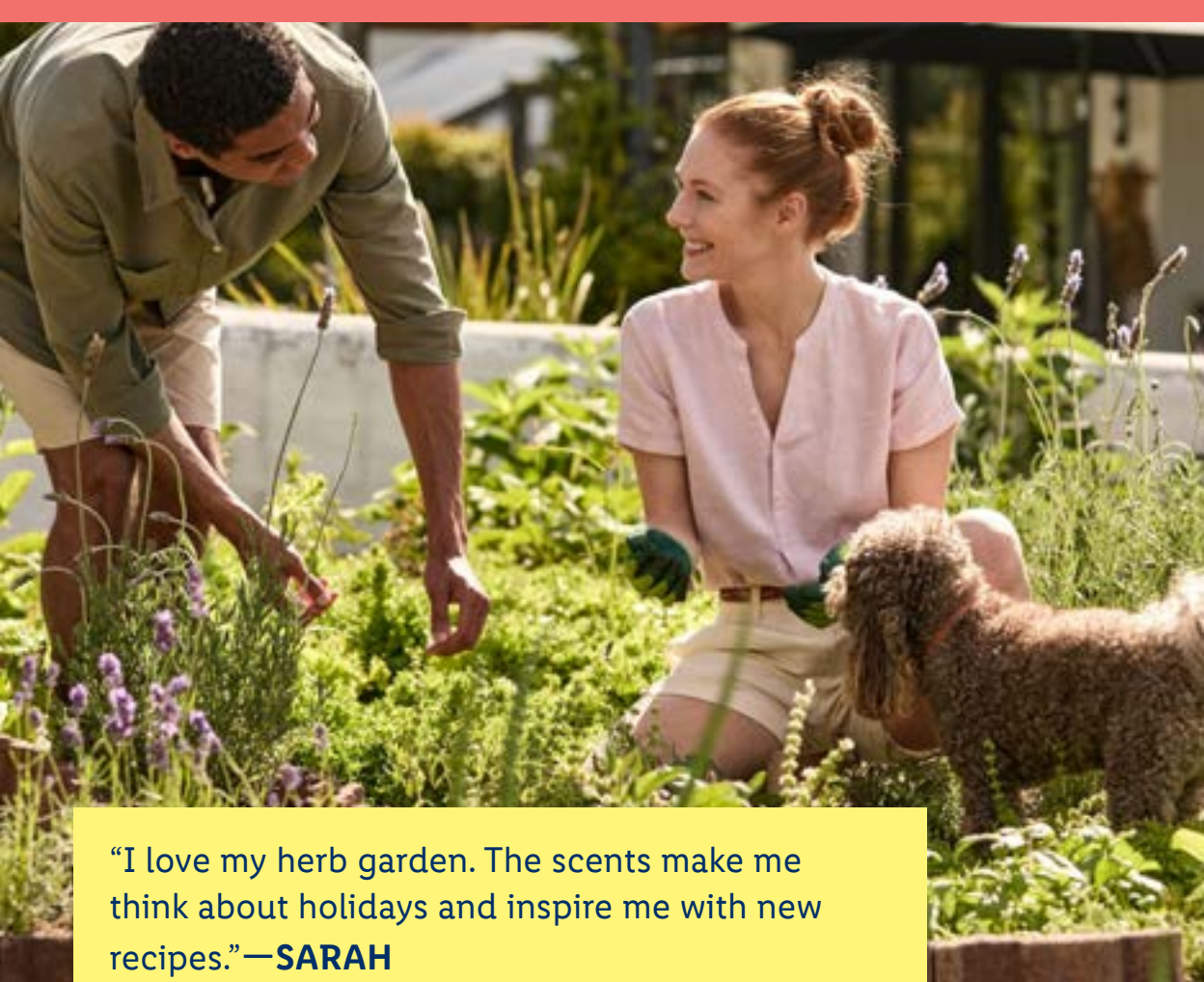

Information and Advice to Protect Yourself from the Sun

In summer, to keep your skin healthy you need to protect it properly!

- Adequately moisturize your skin before heading out.
- Apply sunscreen before any exposure to the sun.
- Don't forget easily missed areas such as the neck, ears, and hairline.
- Avoid exposure to intense sunlight during the peak hours of 10 am to 4 pm.

Tip

How to apply correctly: use approximately 30–40 ml of body sunscreen for full coverage. Stay protected: Reapply every two hours, especially if the sunlight is very intense or if you are working up a sweat in the garden.

Passion, Warmth and Aromas: the Cast Iron for the Barbecue

What to look out for:

- **Care:** when using the pan for the first time, oil it and heat it thoroughly. This forms a **natural non-stick layer**.
- **Proper preheating:** cast iron takes a while to heat up but retains heat **very evenly**.
- **Using the right amount of fat:** a thin layer of oil and fat enhances **the roast's flavour** and **prevents food from sticking**.
- **No cooling:** after use, rinse immediately under hot water and clean with a brush. Cold water can damage the material.

Have You Tried Wood-Fired Cooking?

With wood-fired cooking, fish, meat or vegetables are placed on a **wooden board**, which is placed directly on the grill.

02

The board slowly releases its aroma and the foods absorb a **smoky and intense aroma of wood and charcoal**, without direct contact with the embers.

03

The board is ideal for **tender fillets** or **vegetables**, which otherwise tend to dry out too much.

Chop and slice the tomatoes, finely chop the **onion**, halve **the avocado**, remove the stone and scoop out the flesh. Chop two halves, set the others aside.

02

Marinate the tomatoes, onion and small pieces of avocado with salt, pepper and lemon juice.

03

Cook the burgers on the grill over medium heat for **about 2 minutes on each side** and smash them down.

04

Serve the avocado salad on the plates, placing the hamburgers on top, cut the rest of the avocado into wedges and decorate the hamburgers.

05

Season with **oregano and chili** and serve.
